

## Knitting Notions Pouch

### Materials:

1/2 yd quilting cotton exterior  
1/2 yd quilting cotton for lining  
7 in. zipper  
coordinating all-purpose thread

### Instructions:

- 1) With pattern piece from this page, cut 2 from your exterior fabric and 2 from your lining fabric
- 2) Take one piece of exterior fabric and one piece of lining and pin them together with right sides facing. Sandwich your zipper between the 2 with the right side of your zipper facing the right side of your exterior and the wrong side of the zipper facing the right side of the lining fabric. Using your zipper foot, stitch all pieces together using 1/4 in. seam. Repeat for remaining exterior and lining piece on the other side of the zipper.
- 3) Fold fabric back along the zipper so that wrong sides are facing and press.
- 4) Open your zipper and pin exterior pieces to each other with right sides facing. Pin lining pieces together with right sides facing with zipper teeth tucked toward the lining.
- 5) Stitch all around the exterior with 1/2 in. seam, being careful around zipper ends (they can be tricky and thick). Repeat with lining, leaving a 2-3 in. opening in the bottom for turning.
- 6) Trim your corners- this makes the finished pieces look nice and less bulgy. Turn your pouch right side out but don't tuck your lining in yet. |
- 7) Hand stitch or machine stitch the pouch opening closed and press. Tuck the lining in.

You're Done...now fill your pouch with your knitting notions!
